SECRETARY REPORT (Finn):

TREASURER REPORT (Bennett): The budget right now is about \$67,000. Total membership is down from 2019 renewals. People have either chose not to renew their memberships or have not gotten to it. Even with the money shortfall, estimated to be in the \$7k - \$8k range, there are plenty of resources to get through 2020. There is a huge reduction of major expenditures, considering there are not many events this year.

 - Website (Bishop): Nancy Bishop, who has been a catalyst in the design of the new website, provided an update. The functionality of the site has been greatly simplified, which makes for a smooth navigation experience, which feels much more 21st century. The current process of preparing the website for migration involves updating copy, working intently with the web developer. Chris Rawson was working with the developer to transfer content. - **DIVERSITY & INCLUSION** (Smith-Chávez): Working on a series of virtual programming sessions that address what is being brought up. Sessions were pitched on July 14th, and sessions are set for the rest of the year through June. The new newsletter had its first edition go out but only to a small number of people.
